*Important Note:

Students who absent themselves from any CIE will lose the marks for the respective test. However, if a student is not able to write the CIE I / II because of his/her participation in an important event related to NSS/NCC or Games/Sports representing the College/University/health grounds, the student must get the prior permission of the principal through the proper channel and submit the same to the Office of the Controller of Examinations, Deadline is 7 days after the CIE. Applications submitted after the deadline willnot be considered for the retest.

Component III: Attendance (5 Marks)
