Briefing about the agenda points, the Chair explained the Four-Year Course Framework and syllabus for the I & II semesters is framed keeping in view the diversified needs of stakeholders like students, industrialists and alumni. The syllabus is thoroughly discussed to include changes wherever necessary as per student feedback and also market requirements. The academic flexibility is used to include cross cutting issues in the curriculum. After detailed deliberations, the following resolutions are unanimously made.

RESOLUTIONS:

1. Resolved to approve the Four-Year course framework and syllabus for I & II semesters and to include if any additions with justifications. The syllabus is framed keeping in view the guidelines issued by the UGC, APSCHE and Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajahmundry.
2. Resolved to approve the Course Outcomes (Cos) included in the Board of Studies for each course, to educate students on the outcomes of numerous courses that they are going to study in the ensuing semester.
3. Resolved to approve the following papers for B.A. (Honors) Political Science

 Paper-1: Fundamentals of Social Science
 Paper-2: Perspectives on Indian Society
Semester II
 Paper-3: Fundamentals of Political Science
 Paper-4: Concept and Ideology of Political Science
 Paper-1 (Minor): Fundamentals of Social Science
4. Resolved to approve model question papers carrying 50 marks for semester end examinations and 50 marks for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for I & II semesters. The marks for CIA are further divided into 30 for I & II semesters in written exam, 5 marks for assignment and the remaining 15 marks for assessment by pedagogical techniques.
5. Resolved to approve the pattern of evaluation for project work as follows 50 marks for record, 25 marks for seminar/assignments and the remaining 25 marks for viva.

6. Resolved to approve the list of examiners / Papers setters for the academic year 2023–2024.
7. Resolved to apply new pedagogical (teaching-learning) techniques prescribed by the Commissioner ate of Collegiate Education, A.P. for effective transaction of curriculum to the students.
8. Resolved to approve the syllabus and model question paper for Certificate Course in 50: 50 patterns, i.e. 50 marks for internal assessment and the remaining 50 marks for term end examination.
9. Resolved to approve the list of activities proposed to be conducted by the Department during the academic year 2023-24.
