## **4. The practice**

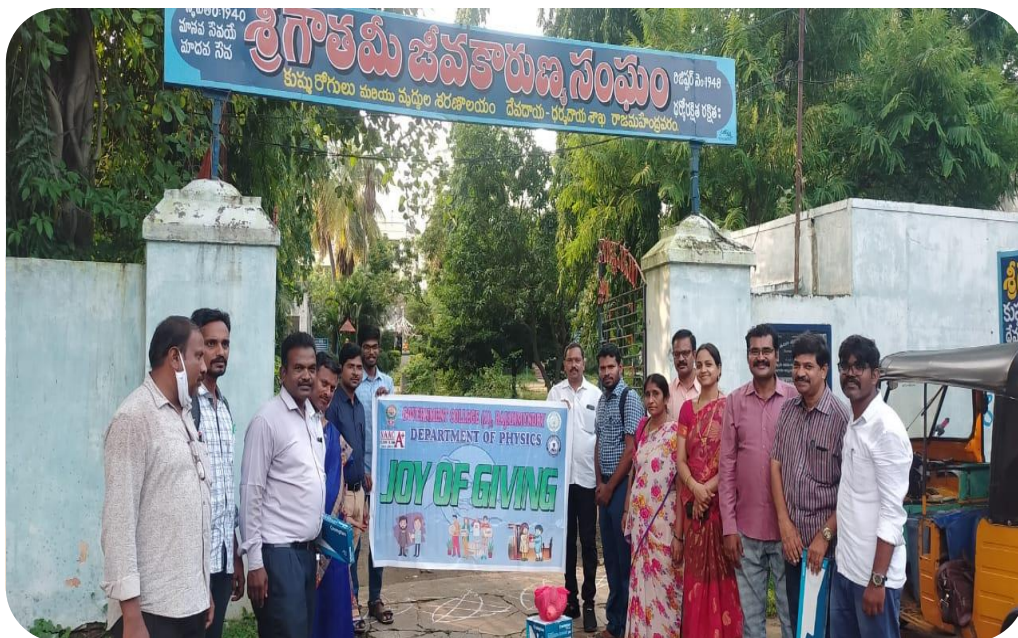
- The Department of Physics & Electronics was kind enough to celebrate the “Joy of giving” by inculcating the habit of giving and sharing.
