**MINUTES OF THE MEETING**

The Board of Studies of Psychology Department was convened on from 04th January 2024 from 2.00 PM onwards in the Department under the Chairmanship of Sri BABJEE POTHURAJU, Course Coordinator of the Department.

Briefing about the agenda points, the Chair explained that the syllabus for I & II semesters is framed keeping in view the diversified needs of stakeholders like students, industrialists and alumni. The syllabus is thoroughly discussed to include changes wherever necessary as per student feedback and also market requirements. The academic flexibility is used to include cross cutting issues in the curriculum. After detailed deliberations, the following resolutions are unanimously made.

**Resolutions:**

1. Resolved to approve the syllabus for I & II semesters. The syllabus is framed keeping in view the guidelines issued by the UGC, APSCHE and Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajahmundry.
2. Resolved to approve the following papers for B.A. (HONORS) PSYCHOLOGY (2023-24)  
Paper I: Fundamentals of Social Sciences  
Paper II: Perspectives on Indian Society  
Paper III: Foundations of Psychology  
Paper IV: Cognitive Psychology  
MDC Paper: Principles of Psychology  
Certificate Course on Gender Psychology
3. Resolved to approve model question papers carrying 50 marks for semester end examinations and 50 marks for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) related to I and II Semesters. The marks for CIA are further divided into 20 marks for internal written exam, 10 marks for online exam, 5 marks for attendance and the remaining 15 marks for assessment by pedagogical techniques.
4. Resolved to approve the list of examiners / Papers setters for the academic year 2023-2024.
5. Resolved to apply new pedagogical (teaching-learning) techniques prescribed by the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, A.P. for effective transaction of curriculum to the students.
6. Resolved to approve the newly added certificate course form the academic year
